## Duped by realtors, BRS activist attempts suicide in Telangana's Sircilla


**Rajanna-Sircilla:** A BRS activist and former MPTC, Karkaboina Kuntaiah, attempted suicide by consuming pesticides after being allegedly cheated by local realtors and receiving no response from the police despite repeated complaints. According to family members, Kuntaiah, a native of Ankushapur village in Thangallapalli mandal, had accompanied other BRS workers to Hyderabad on Monday. While the others returned to the village by night, Kuntaiah did not come back. Concerned about his whereabouts, his family lodged a complaint with the police, who traced his location using mobile signals. Kuntaiah was found



unconscious on the outskirts of the village on Tuesday morning. Upon learning that he had consumed pesticides, police rushed him to hospital for treatment. In a suicide note purportedly written by him, Kuntaiah stated that realtor Ganga Krishna

Reddy had occupied his land worth Rs 10 lakh, while another person, Nagaraju, had sold him fake land. Despite complaints, he claimed, police had failed to can I perform my daughter's marriage when I have nothing left?" he wrote.

## Hyderabad Bird Atlas Season 2 survey to kick off on July 5



Sangareddy: The much-awaited second season of the Hyderabad Bird Atlas (HBA) survey will begin on July 5 across the State capital and continue till July 20. The fortnight-long initiative aims to document the presence and abundance of various bird species in 180 randomly selected regions across Hyderabad. In the first season held in February 2025, over 200 bird watchers participated voluntarily and recorded the presence of 195 different bird species within the Outer Ring Road limits. This year's survey will expand to cover new areas of the city as part of the ongoing effort to track

**Hyderabad:** Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC) Commissioner RV Karnan has directed officials to expedite the beautification works of the Shilpa Layout Phase-2 flyover, which is nearing completion and will soon be opened to traffic. The Commissioner inspected the flyover on Tuesday, which has been constructed from the Outer Ring Road (ORR) to Gachibowli at a cost of Rs. 178 crore. With civil works completed, he instructed officials to finish the remaining beautification and greening tasks immediately. Karnan also directed engineering officials to install transfer bars (rumble strips) as per Indian Roads Congress (IRC) guidelines. Further, he asked officials to inspect the com-

## Biogas plant in OU Women's hostels changes campus environment, reduces LPG, firewood consumption

**Hyderabad:** The installation of a biogas plant in the women's hostels at Osmania University (OU) has resulted in a noticeable reduction in LPG usage and firewood consumption, contributing to a more sustainable and eco-friendly campus. In December 2024, the Mahalakshmi Biogas Plant was inaugurated on the premises of the Women's Hostel in OU. The plant was set up by Saahas under the ReSET CSR initiative funded by KPMG India. Operator of Ahuja Engineering Company, which installed the plant, Sandeep, explaining the process of generating biogas from food waste, said, "We have arranged designated bins in the mess at all the hostels. The plant processes 2 tons of wet (food) waste, which is collected daily from the mess of the hostels and is transported to the site through an electric vehicle." At the site, the bins are weighed and the food waste reaches the sorting table, where it is crushed in the crusher and mixed with slurry, fed to the digester tank.



Here, anaerobic digestion takes place in the digester to form biogas, said the operator. The biogas is generated in a tank and then passes through the H2S and water trap scrubber to absorb H2S and moisture. In this process, the biogas is purified to around 60% methane content. This purified gas is stored in the biogas storage balloons from where it is supplied to the kitchen through a pipeline system, Sandeep said. "We have provided biogas stoves to the kitchens for preparing food for hostel inmates. Through this biogas, food preparation

can be done for 300 to 400 members," he said. "It was a challenging task for us to handle the food waste generated from the hostels, which used to be sent to those rearing cattle," Director, Campus Hostels for Women, Osmania University, Y Kalyana Lakshmi, told Telangana Today. This situation often led to unsanitary conditions and unpleasant odours in the area, she said. "After the biogas plant, we are saving on firewood and LPG gas for which every month, we used to spend Rs 40,000 to 50,000," the Director explained.

## Air India San Francisco-Mumbai flight delayed at Kolkata after engine snag; passengers deplaned

**Kolkata:** An Air India flight from San Francisco to Mumbai faced a technical snag in one of its engines, forcing all passengers to deplane during a scheduled halt at Kolkata airport early on Tuesday. Flight AI180 landed on time at 12:45 am, but a problem in the left engine caused a delay in its onward journey. At around 5:20 am, an announcement was made onboard instructing all passengers to disem-



bark. The captain informed passengers that the decision was taken in the interest of flight safety.

## Sangareddy man jailed for life for killing cousin over petty row

**Sangareddy:** A man who killed his cousin over a petty issue was sentenced to life imprisonment by Principal District and Sessions Judge G Bhavani Chandra. According to police, the convict, Mangali Bhaskar, a resident of Madaram in Jinnaram mandal, had an argument with his cousin Mangali Babu (26) over a trivial matter on



November 19, 2021. In a fit

of rage, Bhaskar stabbed Babu with a broken beer bottle, resulting in his death. After examining the evidence and hearing arguments from both sides, the judge pronounced the verdict on Tuesday.

## Singareni's growth top priority for Telangana government: Bhatti Vikramarka

**Jayashankar-Bhupalpally:** Deputy Chief Minister Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka stated that strengthening the Singareni Collieries Company Limited (SCCL), a public sector enterprise employing over 45,000 people, was a top priority for the State government to safeguard livelihood opportunities for future generations. The Deputy CM conducted a review meeting with senior officials at the Singareni General Manager's office in Bhupalpally on Tuesday. He said the government's primary objective was to ensure that Singareni remained profitable for the benefit of its employees, local communities, and the State exchequer. He noted that while SCCL and Coal India once held monopoly in the coal sector, global shifts in the coal industry have now necessitated Singareni's preparedness to withstand market competition. He advised officials and staff to consistently compare coal produc-



tion costs and market prices, both of private players and SCCL, to ensure competitiveness. To enhance transparency, he instructed officials to install display boards at mining sites showing production costs and market prices of coal to raise awareness among workers and officers. Drawing attention to Singareni's 136-year history in mining, the Deputy CM urged the company to explore other mineral opportunities beyond coal. He suggested appoint-

ing consultants to assess global demand for critical minerals and study their availability. Failing to plan ahead, he warned, would risk harming future generations. Responding to complaints from locals, the Deputy CM directed officials to investigate and submit a report on the impact of mining operations on two villages in Bhupalpally constituency. The review meeting was attended by Minister Duddilla Sridhar Babu and others.

### Phone-tapping case: TPCC president appears before SIT

**Hyderabad:** TPCC president Mahesh Kumar Goud on Tuesday appeared before the Special Investigation Team (SIT) of the State Police probing the phone-tapping case. Speaking to media persons later, the TPCC president alleged that the previous government had tapped phones of political leaders, including those from Telugu Desam and BJP. This was also one of

losing the 2018 elections, he claimed. A notice to TPCC chief over phone-tapping allegation A complaint was lodged with the then Chief Secretary over the issue. Stern action should be initiated against all those involved in the scandal, the TPCC president demanded.

## Neglect leaves Palamuru-Rangareddy Lift Irrigation Scheme tunnels clogged

**Hyderabad:** Nearly two years of neglect have pushed the Palamuru-Rangareddy Lift Irrigation Scheme (PRLIS) into a precarious state, with clogged tunnels and submerged structures and equipment. Experts warn that leaking passages and poor maintenance could destabilise local hydrology and endanger fragile ecosystems. Without urgent intervention, this flagship project risks becoming another unfulfilled promise in Telangana's troubled irrigation history. Just two days ago, Deputy Chief Minister Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka had assured that the Congress-led government would expedite PRLIS completion, stressing timely fund releases to fast-track progress. The aim is to transform the drought-hit lands of Mahabubnagar into fertile zones, turning Palamuru into the "rice bowl" of India. Irrigation Minister N Uttam Kumar Reddy too echoed this commitment, setting an ambitious deadline of December to be fast-tracked over the next six months. However, engineers, speaking on condition of anonymity, expressed concern that PRLIS has lost the special focus it received under the previous BRS regime. They warned that continued neglect of maintenance could have catastrophic consequences. Cracks could form in concrete linings or unlined tunnel walls due to soil shifts,



weathering or minor seismic tremors common in the region. Seepage from these fissures could weaken surrounding soil, risking subsidence or landslides. Inside the tunnels, sediment, including silt, rocks and organic debris like roots, has begun to accumulate, clogging water flow. Stagnant water fosters bacterial growth and algae, while corrosion threatens steel components, weakening the entire structure. Prolonged lack of upkeep could drastically escalate revival costs. PRLIS is a critical project designed to irrigate 12.3 lakh acres and supply drinking water to 1,226 villages across the six districts of Mahabubnagar, Vikarabad, Narayanpet, Rangareddy and Nalgonda. The scheme's tunnels, some several kilometres long and up to 10 metres in diameter, are meant to lift and transport massive volumes of water across five stages through rugged terrain. With Rs.31,000 crore already spent and 85 per cent of the work completed under the

BRS government, the project held the promise of transforming parched farmlands. But since 2023, work has largely stalled. Pumping units have already been submerged once, and continued neglect threatens further structural damage.

Engineers fear PRLIS may go the way of the Parambikulam Aliyar Project (PAP) in Tamil Nadu and Kerala. Launched in the 1950s, PAP faced decades of neglect and delay, and by the 1980s, unmaintained tunnels were clogged with debris, and seepage damaged the infrastructure, inflating costs. Andhra Pradesh's Polavaram project also saw tunnel and canal works stall due to funding issues and political uncertainty, resulting in sedimentation and structural decay. The PRLIS now stands at a crossroads. The estimated cost has ballooned to Rs.65,506 crore, with Rs.33,201 crore still required. Despite assurances, experts worry that the project has been placed on the back burner by the Congress government.

## Elephant from Andhra Pradesh to grace Bonalu, Moharram processions in Hyderabad

**Hyderabad:** This year, the annual Bonalu festivities and Moharram processions in the city will feature an elephant from Andhra Pradesh, unlike last year when the animal was brought from Karnataka. The decision was taken after the Mutt at Davanagere in Karnataka declined the Telangana Endowments Department's request to permit an elephant for religious processions. The reasons for the refusal remain unclear. Following this, an appeal was made to a Mutt in Anantapur, Andhra Pradesh, which responded positively. A No Objection Certificate (NOC) for the formal appeal from the Endowments Department has already been approved, according to a Forest Department official. Once the Andhra Pradesh Forest Department grants its NOC, other formalities will be completed. The elephant from Anantapur has reportedly been trained to participate in various religious processions, the official added. The arrangements were initiated after the Akkanna Madanna Mahankali temple formally approached the Endowments Department requesting an elephant for the Bonalu festivities. Although Bonalu



is celebrated as a State festival, the temple made a formal request to the department only last month, said Mahankali temple general Dattatreya. Apart from this temple, others including the Sri Ujjaini Mahankali temple in Secunderabad and the Nalla Pochamma temple in Sabzi Mandi also organise processions. After the Bonalu festivities, the same elephant will be used in the Bibi-Ka-Alam procession held during Moharram. Arranging an elephant a cumbersome process. Every year, the Endowments Department faces a challenge in arranging an elephant for various religious processions. Temple committees and other religious organisations seeking to conduct processions submit formal appeals to the department, paying requisite charges. The arrangements include transportation of the elephant, deployment of veterinary doctors, and the presence of trainers. The department must then obtain a NOC from the Forest department. After securing approval from the other State, the elephant is brought to Telangana. To avoid this cumbersome process, both the Forest and Endowments departments have urged major temples such as those in Yadagirigutta and Vemulawada to adopt elephants. However, temple managements are still evaluating the pros and cons of adoption, including the cost of maintenance. Arrangements and other logistical factors, the official added.

## Six arrested in Jalpally arson incident that sparked mild communal tension

**Hyderabad:** The Mailardevpally police on Monday arrested six people for a DCM arson incident at Jalpally on Sunday evening that caused mild communal tension. Tense moments were witnessed at Jalpally, Pahadishareef, after some persons stopped a vehicle allegedly carrying animal waste, attacked two people grievously, and burnt their vehicle. The development forced members of the butchers' community and cattle traders to gather in large numbers on the Jalpally road. The Mailardevpally police reached the spot and brought the situation under control and barricaded the area to prevent any untoward incident. Meanwhile, the situation remained peaceful at Musheerabad, where a group protested in front of



the police station over a derogatory social media post targeting a particular community on Sunday night. Some local youngsters from Musheerabad had noticed a post on social media with distasteful content and assembled in front of the local police station, demanding action against the person who had posted the content. On assurances from higher officials, the crowd dispersed from the spot after giving a representation to the police. On the other hand, the local police said the situation was under control in Attapur, where mild tension prevailed after some persons stopped a vehicle carrying cattle and attacked the driver resulting in clash between two groups on Sunday.

## Hyderabad: Traffic restrictions on Lakdikapul Road for one month due to drain work

**Hyderabad:** The Hyderabad Traffic Police have imposed nighttime traffic restrictions on Lakdikapul Road between 11 pm and 5 am due to the construction of a stormwater drain at Lakdikapul junction. The restrictions will take effect from Wednesday night and remain in force for one month. It spans a total distance of 180 metres, starting from the Intelligence Office to Dwaraka Hotel, passing by Lucky Restaurant and Venkateshwara Hotel (Old PS Saifabad Junction). Traffic from Nirankari towards Iqbal Minar will be diverted via Ravindra Bharathi. Vehicles moving from Ravindra Bharathi to



Old PS Saifabad will be diverted at Iqbal Minar towards Secretariat Junction. Similarly, traffic from Secretariat Junction to Old PS Saifabad will be redirected at Iqbal Minar. The traffic police have advised commuters to use alternative routes during the restricted hours and requested public cooperation in following the advisory.
